Guidelines for Applicants:

I. The applicant must:

A. Be a member of the current Senior Class of Bethel Park High School

and

B. Score 900 or above on the S.A.T. (Scholastic Aptitude Test), or 22 on the A.C.T. (American College Testing) composite.

and

C. Have maintained a cumulative grade point average (G.P.A.) of 3.00 or above Through mid-year of his/her senior year.

And

- D. Had completed in a varsity sport and been awarded at least (1) varsity letter award.
- II. The completed scholarship application <u>must be received</u> by the Waldie Scholarship Committee <u>on or before April 15, 2025.</u>
- III. In addition to the completed application, the applicant:
 - A. Must be enrolled full-time for the upcoming Fall Term and intend to obtain a four-year degree.
 - B. Must submit a copy of his/her school transcript, showing S.A.T. or A.C.T. scores and the G.P.A. transcript.
 - C. If attending a test-optional or test-flexible university or college, the applicant must include any school requirements, i.e. supplemental essay or personal statement.
 - D. Must submit an essay of not less than 350 words on "Character" double-spaced
 - E. No Al-created essays are accepted.
